How to increase the value of every donation you make to The Pepper Foundation – at no cost to you!

Government legislation means that The Pepper Foundation can reclaim the tax you have paid on all donations that you make after 6th April 2000. Completing a simple Gift Aid Declaration makes it easy for us to reclaim tax on donations of any size at absolutely no cost to you.

We urge you to complete the Gift Aid Declaration below and return it to us – the tax reclaimed will make a real difference to the amount of care we can provide to patients and families.

Notes

- 1 You must pay an amount of income tax and/or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax that The Pepper Foundation reclaims on your donations in the tax year (currently 28p for each £1 you give).
- 2 If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and capital gains equal to the tax that The Pepper Foundation reclaims, you should cancel your declaration (see note 1). You can cancel this declaration at any time by notifying The Pepper Foundation.
